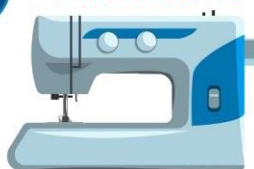

We want to make it as easy as possible for you to identify the correct level of piano protection for your purposes. To this end we have prepared a visual aid, a detailed description and a video of what each style has to offer your piano. Your discount voucher offer is also in this guide 😊

Step 1 – Choosing The Right Level Of Protection:

At ROQSOLID we manufacture 3 styles of piano cover:

- LightGuard
- PowerGuard
- PremierGuard.

Whilst all 3 offer dust and damp / spill protection, each style offers a different level of **bump, knock / impact protection**.

On the right is a graphical representation of the 3 styles and what level of protection each offers.

As you can see, the greater the number of layers, the better impact protection – as you would expect because the cover is thicker.

Here is a fuller description of the various styles:

1. LightGuard:

- LightGuard covers are made up of 2 layers
- An outer layer of pu-coated* nylon to **protect against damp and spills**
- An inner layer of non-scratch felt to **protect the piano's polished surface**

2. PowerGuard:

- PowerGuard covers are made up of 3 layers
- An outer layer of pu-coated* nylon to **protect against damp and spills**
- An inner layer of non-scratch felt to **protect the piano's polished surface**
- A layer of 'dacron' padding sandwiched in-between to **protect the piano against mild bumps and knocks**
- The 3 layers are diamond quilted together providing an aesthetically pleasing cover, suitable for private home use, schools, churches, colleges, music academies, music studios, universities and restaurants
- PowerGuard is our most popular style and the one most schools, churches, universities, colleges and private piano owners choose

3. PremierGuard Covers Have 5 Layers:

- PremierGuard covers are made up of 5 layers
- An outer layer of pu-coated* nylon to **protect against damp and spills**
- Double layers of non-scratch felt to **protect the piano's polished surface**
- Double layers of 'dacron' padding sandwiched in-between to **protect the piano against *mild to moderate* bumps and knocks**
- The 5 layers are diamond quilted together providing an aesthetically pleasing cover, suitable for private home use, schools, churches, colleges, music academies, music studios, universities and restaurants when additional impact protection is required such as during removals & storage or when the piano is in high traffic situations at increased risk of impact

*polyurethane - polyurethane has extremely strong water-repellent characteristics.


